

## WHAT IS A PRESCRIBED OCCUPATION?

A person must hold a certificate of competency before they perform any work in a prescribed occupation. Below is a table detailing what prescribed occupations are.

OCCUPATION	CODE	INFORMATION
Dogging	DG	Includes selection and inspection of lifting gear including slinging and movement of loads handled by a crane.
Rigging- Basic	RB	Includes movement of plant and equipment including steel erection. This certificate encompasses the DG certificate.
Rigging- Intermediate	RI	Includes equalising gear tilt slabs and rigging of cranes. This certificate encompasses the DG and RB certificates.
Rigging- Advanced	RA	Includes gin poles, suspended, fabricated and hung scaffolds. This certificate encompasses the DG, RG and RI certificates.
Scaffolding- Basic	SB	Includes prefabricated, bracket, tank and formwork scaffolds
Scaffolding- Intermediate	SI	Includes tube and coupler, spurred and cantilever scaffolds This certificate encompasses the SB certificate.
Scaffolding- Advanced	SA	Includes hung scaffolds, scaffolds hanging from tubes, wire ropes, chains and suspended scaffolds This certificate encompasses the SB and SI certificates.
Crane or hoist operation	CS	Operator of a self-erecting tower crane
	CT	Operator of a tower crane
	CD	Operator of a derrick crane
	CP	Operator of a portal boom crane
	CB	Operator of a bridge or gantry crane (other than operation by a remote control having not more than 3 powered operations
	CV	Operator of a vehicle loading crane with a capacity of 10 metre tonnes or more
	CN	Operator of a non-slewing mobile crane with a capacity of more than 3 tonnes. This certificate includes non-slewing articulated mobile cranes.
	C2	Operator of a slewing mobile crane with a capacity of 20 tonnes or less. This certificate encompasses the CV and CN certificates
	C6	Operator of a slewing mobile crane with a capacity of 60 tonnes or less. This certificate encompasses the CV, CN and C2 certificates.
	C1	Operator of a slewing mobile crane with a capacity of 100 tonnes or less. This certificate encompasses the CV, CN, C2 and C6 certificates.
	C0	Operator of a slewing mobile crane with a capacity of more than 100 tonnes. This certificate encompasses the CV, CN, C2, C6 and C1 certificates.
	HM	Operator of a materials hoist with a cantilever platform
	HP	Operator of a materials or personnel hoist
WP	Operator of a boom-type work platform with a boom length of 11 metres or more	
PB	Operator of a mobile truck mounted concrete placing boom with a knuckle boom capable of power operated slewing and luffing	

# PREScribed OCCUPATIONS

OCCUPATION	CODE	INFORMATION
Pressure equipment operation	BB	Basic boiler operator - boilers with a single fixed combustion air supply and a non-modulating single heat source and a fixed firing rate
	BI	Intermediate boiler operator - boilers with a modulating combustion air supply or modulating heat source or a superheater or economiser. This certificate encompasses the BB certificate
	BA	Advanced boiler operator - multiple fuel type boilers which may be fired simultaneously. This certificate encompasses the BB and BI certificates
	TO	Turbine operator - turbines with power output of 500kw or more
	ES	Reciprocating steam engine operator - steam engines with a piston diameter of more than 250mm
Loadshifting equipment operation	LBG	Operator of a bridge or gantry crane - if a load more than 5 tonne is being lifted by remote control with no more than 3 powered operations
	LZ	Operator of a dozer
	LE	Operator of an excavator having an engine capacity of more than 2 litres
	LL	Operator of a front-end loader having an engine capacity of more than 2 litres
	LB	Operator of a front-end loader/backhoe having an engine capacity of more than 2 litres
	LG	Operator of a grader
	LR	Operator of a road roller having an engine capacity of more than 2 litres
	LS	Operator of a skid steer loader having an engine capacity of more than 2 litres
	LP	Operator of a scraper
	LF	Operator of a fork lift truck (other than a pedestrian operated fork lift truck)
LO	Operator of an order picking fork lift truck	

## WHAT IS A PRESCRIBED ACTIVITY?

In order to be authorised to perform a prescribed activity a person is required to be assessed as competent by an authorised accredited provider or a registered training organisation.

A certificate to perform a prescribed activity is valid for 2 years from the day it is granted unless suspended or cancelled.

### ASBESTOS REMOVAL

Asbestos removal work is a prescribed activity. There are two classes of certificates for the performance of work which involves the removal of asbestos.

'A' class- Required for removal of any amount of friable asbestos-containing material

'B' class- Required for removal of 10m<sup>2</sup> or more of bonded asbestos-containing material

### DEMOLITION WORK

There are two classes of certificates for the performance of demolition work if it is a prescribed activity:

D1 – Authorises the holder to perform Demolition work

D2 – Authorises the holder to supervise Demolition work

The following table is designed to help decide whether the work is a prescribed activity.

Follow through Step 1 and 2 to decide whether the Demolition Work is a Prescribed Activity			
<b>STEP 1:</b> Demolition work <b>IS</b> a prescribed activity if you can answer <b>Yes</b> to the following questions			
1	Is the work to demolish or dismantle systematically a structure*, or part of a structure?	YES	
2	Does the structure contain pre-tensioned or post-tensioned structural components? <b>OR</b> Does the work involve the use of load shifting equipment or explosives or another induced collapse method?	YES  YES	
<b>STEP 2:</b> Demolition <b>IS NOT</b> a prescribed activity if you answer <b>Yes</b> to any of the following questions			
3	Is the work the systematic dismantling of a part of a structure for alteration, maintenance, remodelling or repair?		NO
4	Is the work the systematic dismantling of formwork, falsework, scaffold or other construction designed or used to provide support, access or containment during construction work?		NO
5	Is the structure a domestic house, a structure built as, and still having generally the characteristics of, a domestic house, or a structure that is ancillary to either of the above (i.e. a carport).		NO
